

Contac Acquires Assets of Forum Productions Inc.

With the added capacity and technology, Contac’s Print Division is now one of the leading print facilities in Canada. The acquisition of these printing assets allows Contac to significantly increase daily print output to more than 1.6 million sheets per 8-hour shift on offset presses. Contac’s client base across North America, in both the travel industry and other industries, can take advantage of the additional digital and offset print production capacity, with faster output and greater efficiencies.

Forum’s current clients will be transitioned to Contac including Canada Post, the City of Vancouver, Tourism Richmond, Tourism Vancouver Island, Boston Pizza, Direct Buy, Canadian Cancer Society, Frequency Magazine, Vancouver Community College and hundreds more.
